Reports:

- <u>Fire Wise Presentation</u>, -Jake Hardt, representative from Washington DNR, Landowner Assistant Program, NorthEast Region
 - Jake presented info about the programs and resources available to communities like ours
 - -cost share program that can help our members firewise their properties
 - -it's easiest to do it as a group, but individual assessments and advice are available.
 - -Karen M will work on getting the free assessment for whole community and the greenbelts, and Jake will then work with individual owners who want to be in
- <u>Treasurer's Report-</u> handout with current financial standings given lots of people paid their dues in January so we are in good shape
- Architectural Committee Report Phil not present, no report
- Road Committee Report discussion around extensive ice this year and other issues. Kitty is willing to be back-up for plowing and sanding calls if Phil unavailable
 - -Steve S. will be in contact with Adam Fulton who has experience with road engineering he will take a look at our development in the spring and identify road issues will work on hourly basis, -will be a spring/summer project and will be ongoing

OLD BUSINESS:

- <u>Computer and Camera updates</u> cameras are in place at garbage and we don't need to call Wastewise anymore, new computers up and running
 - -discussion around switching to Methownet internet service—see if we can decrease costs of our internet -will try to decrease Century link bill in the meantime—cancel fax and land line
- Lien filings and releases released one and filed four new ones

- Website discussion re: positive response to newsletter and website 19 hits on website after newsletter e-mailing
 - would need to change our plan if we want to increase website content- Steve G could talk with
 Andy re: changing website and what cost would be. Our cost is personal plan, not business plan at present. You could re-up personal with a different plan but still cheaper than business.
 -will be working on a better map of development on website
- <u>Keycard cancellations for 20-19 dues unpaid</u>-Kathi has list of people that are in arrears and cards will be cancelled by March 31st. An email and printed letter will go out to all of them. -amended keycard policy will be put on the website
